Space Planning, Design, Remodeling, Office Furniture Solutions

The existing 3,500 square foot office space had never been designed just taken as is and the employees were working in old mismatched furniture with white walls and ancient carpet. We assisted the client with enlarging the Executive Office, Conference room and Kitchen/Employee Lounge spaces, planning new offices configurations and workstations for the staff. We increased the staff count by 3 employees and updated lighting throughout the office space. The color scheme began with new patterned carpet tiles throughout the office space and broadloom with borders for the Executive Office and Conference room areas. Accent colors were chosen to brighten the office areas and provide a cheerier workplace. New cherry wood furnishings were selected to have a rich look without overpowering the smaller spaces.

Reception Area

Handsome Cherry Wood Furniture, Custom Reception Desk with Glass Transaction Countertop, Wall-Mounted Cabinets, Tackboard and Task Lighting. Wood Frame Guest Chairs and Tables, Copper Colored Upholstery, and new Patterned Carpet Tiles in a light neutral color open up the space.



Executive office with, Cherry Wood furniture, custom draperies, translucent mesh shades and accessories. The office is on a curved section of the building with amazing views of the US Capitol Building and the US Supreme Court. This space was originally used as the Conference Room just off the Reception area with the Executive's office in the back of the workplace. We switched the locations providing visitor's access without walking throughout the entire office space.

New hallway File Cabinets were ordered to clean up the mismatch of older cabinets in every size, shape and color. The Association had inherited furniture wherever it could given its charitable work.

Dimmable Track lighting provides accent and drama to this narrow interior corridor.

New furniture was ordered for 85% of the office and staff providing modern efficient workspaces for all employees.



New workstations cleaned up the open areas and provided employees with individual workspaces.

New sidelights were added to all the Private Offices allowing daylight into the interior work area.



The new Conference Room was enlarged by 2'-0" in width and a new 10'-0" racetrack table allows a space for all employees to meet comfortably within the room for staff meetings. Access ports for laptops are provided in the new cherry plastic laminate table. Ergonomic seating is used throughout the project, this seating line allows for fabric cover replacement should a chair's fabric become soiled or torn.



The enlarged Kitchen area is now used as an Employee Lounge and the 48" round table is used regularly for lunch by the staff. Comfortable ergonomic chairs flex with the user. New wood cabinetry and Silestone countertops complete the Kitchen transformation. Playful colors were used with the simple VCT flooring, providing a clean and sophisticated look.



Private Office spaces were a combination of the few good pieces of existing furniture and new work walls customized to each office. This employee requested a stand up table desk for their work wall. New ergonomic seating was ordered throughout the office providing each employee with a new adjustable chair.
